The Individuals with Disabilities Educational Act (IDEA) lists 13 different disability categories under which 3- through 21-year-olds may be eligible for services. The disability categories listed in IDEA are:

- 1. Autism (AU)
- 2. Deaf-Blindness (DB)
- 3. Developmental Delay (DD)
- 4. Emotional Disability (EmD)
- 5. Hearing Impairment (HI)
- 6. Intellectual Disability (ID)
- 7. Multiple Disabilities (MD)
- 8. Orthopedic Impairment (OI)
- 9. Other Health Impairment (OHI)
- 10. Specific Learning Disability (SLD)
- 11. Speech or Language Impairment (LS)
- 12. Traumatic Brain Injury (TBI)
- 13. Visual Impairment (VI)
